Heresy is false teaching. The etymology of heresy is choosing one's own thought.

John 8:44 (NIV)

2 Peter, 1-3 (NIV) John, and Jude

2 Peter 1:19-21 (NIV)

3 Characteristics of God's Word: It is

- 1) Reliable
- 2) Light
- 3) Holy Spirit Inspired

Choosing one's own thoughts

2 Peter 2:1-2 (NIV)

5 Characteristics of Heresy:

- It originates from false prophets and false teachers
- It is secretive, subtle, and destructive
- The goal of heresy is to deny God's Sovereignty
- It brings destruction and depraved conduct to its believers
- It disgraces and discredits our faith

What were the heresies in 2 Peter-Jude and how were they addressed?

1) *2 Peter*: No return of Christ, therefore no final judgement.
